SURGICAL OPERATIONS. - We are much gratified to learn that the operation of Lithotripsy, (for crushing the stone in the bladder,) was performed with entire success, on Friday, at the Infirmary attached to the University of Maryland, by Professor Wm. N. Baker. The patient was a little girl, not more than ten years of age, an orphan from the Catholic Asylum in Frankfort, Ky. She had been afflicted with the stone for several years. A large crowd assembled to see the stone, and of course, went home disappointed. The patient in this case, was a colored boy about ten years old. The stone, which we have seen, weighs 131 drachms, is of the oval form, and is considerably larger than a common stone. The operation occupied less than three minutes, and was performed in the presence of the Medical Class, and a large number of students. The operation was successful, and the patient is doing well, and has by this fortunate intervention, escaped a life of suffering to which death would be far preferable. - Balt. Chronicle.
