ISAAC J. MARTIN, PRINCIPAL.

THE Second Session of this Academy will commence on Monday, September 24, 1845.

This institution is to impart to the pupils a thorough knowledge of the usual branches of an English Education, viz: Orthography, Reading, Penmanship, Arithmetic, Geometry, Mensuration, Algebra, Geography, English Grammar, with Composition and Epitaphary Writing, History, Natural Philosophy, Chemistry, Botany, &c.

The Discipline of the Academy is strictly practical, and has direct reference to the development of the moral principle.
