REASSEMBLING OF CONGRESS ON MONDAY. The assembling of Congress on Monday last, after a recess of eleven days, was expected to be marked by several movements of importance.

IN THE HOUSE. Mr. CLINGMAN, of North Carolina, who is now at the head of the Committee on Foreign Affairs, made a call upon the President of the United States for copies of the correspondence of the Secretary of State, and especially that relating to the course of Com. Paulding in the expedition of Gen. Walker.

THE NATIONAL INTELLIGENCER CALLS ATTENTION TO THE FACT THAT IN HAMBURG, where an exclusive metallic currency prevails, the late president and his cabinet have been as great as in countries where they circulated a paper currency, and that the business people there were not so much benefited with a plethora of specie as to disdain the aid that may be furnished by National Banks established in this country.

PAULDING'S EXPEDITION.—Mr. L. V. Shearer, of Frederick county, while engaged in butchering last week, met with a painful accident. He was assisting in pulling a hog out of the hot water, when, by some mishap, the tub containing the water fell over him, scalding him very severely.

WALKER'S EXPEDITION.—Gen. Walker estimates his losses by the failure of the expedition at one hundred and forty thousand dollars. It is also stated that the filibuster on board the Sargatos, at Norfolk, positively refused to go ashore, unless they can be put off by force.

DEATH OF A UNITED STATES JUDGE.—Hon. Henry Potter, Judge of the District Court of the United States in North Carolina, died at his residence near Fayetteville, on the 20th ult. Judge Potter was born in Mecklenburg county, N. C., in 1792.

CALL ACCEPTED.—Most of readers, we presume, will be glad to learn that Rev. Dr. Dorey, of Jefferson, Frederick county, Md., has accepted the call to become the pastor of the Lutheran Church of this place.

RESIGNED.—We learn that John V. Mason, jr., has sent in to the President his resignation as Major in the U. S. Navy.
